Re: Clarification of progress in case the company was accused of fraud in requesting a refund of duty

Refer to Letter No. SAM018/2016 dated 30 May 2016

According to Samchai Steel Industries Public Company Limited (the “Company”) has explained the facts to the Stock Exchange of Thailand. In the event that the Customs Department has announced the arrest of a fraudulent process in requesting a refund of duty Steel products under Section 19 bis, total damage value of more than 120 million baht on May 30, 2016, alleging that the company participate in the process resolution according to the company explained in the referenced book.

The company would like to inform that in order to maintain the reputation of doing business in accordance with good governance After the company Having been alluded to by the Customs Department, the company has filed a lawsuit against the Customs Department and 5 other customs officers in criminal cases on charges of unlawful duties causing damage to the Company. by jointly arresting and reporting allegations to the company Charged with fraud, requesting a refund of duty, although the facts have not yet appeared that the Company Has filed for a duty refund as alleged. Now, the Supreme Court has ordered such criminal case that the case is prima facie and the Court of First Instance shall accept the charge only from the 5 customs officials to proceed with the proceedings in the Court of First Instance.

The Company will notify the progress of various litigation cases related to the dispute which causes the Company to Lose this reputation to the Stock Exchange of Thailand for further acknowledgment.
