Re: Clarification of the progress of disputes between the companies with the Customs Department
(additional)

Refer to the letter No. SAM001/2565 dated January 13, 2022, subject: Clarification of the Company's actions in the case of fraud allegations in requesting a refund of duty.

According to the letter referred to, Samchai Steel Industries Public Company Limited (“the Company”) clarified the criminal case against which the Company File a lawsuit against the Customs Department and 5 other Customs Department officials for allegedly acting illegally causing damage to the company. To protect and maintain the reputation of the company which the Supreme Court has considered and ordered the criminal case to be grounded resolution as described in the referenced book;

The company would like to inform you that In addition to the criminal cases that the Company Having done the above, the Company has filed a civil lawsuit against the Customs Department. to claim compensation for damages arising from an offense against the Company in the amount of money 1,333,921,062.67 baht (one thousand three hundred thirty-three million nine hundred twenty-one thousand sixty-two baht sixty-seven satang), which was previously considered by the Civil Court. that this case is a civil case related to a criminal case (which one of the criminal cases The Supreme Court has considered and ordered the case to be valid according to the letter referred to it). The Civil Court is obliged to hold the facts as appeared in the case and the judgment of the criminal case. Therefore, there was an order to temporarily dispose of the civil case. And if the facts in such criminal cases are final when? Let the parties make a statement to the Civil Court in order to raise the civil case for further consideration.



The Company will notify the progress of various lawsuits related to the dispute which causes the Company to Lose this reputation to the market. Securities of Thailand for further acknowledgment.
